<b><u>DATE</u></b>	<b><u>ITINERARY</u></b>

<b><i>Wed 25 July AMSTERDAM</i></b>	Another day to continue exploring Amsterdam. Anne Frank House, the Rijksmuseum and Van Gogh Museum are just some of the not-to-be-missed attractions. The city has so much to offer and being summer, the outdoor cafes are a great place to relax Tonight is our second game @ Hurley Hockey Club
<b><i>Thurs 26 July ROTTERDAM</i></b>	This morning we board the coach and head down to Rotterdam. After checking in to the hotel, spend the evening in this beautiful port city
<b><i>Fri 27 July ROTTERDAM</i></b>	Take the chance to see the key attractions including Erasmus Bridge, Euromast, Maritime Museum and cruise the harbour. Tonight is Match 3 against Rotterdam Hockey Club
<b><i>Sat 28 July ANTWERP</i></b>	This morning, we head across the border to Brussels and the magnificent city of Antwerp. Being the weekend, there will plenty to see and do during the afternoon, before enjoying a night out in the city
<b><i>Sun 29 July ANTWERP</i></b>	After a relaxing morning, this afternoon we will visit Royal Antwerp Hockey Club for Game 4, and enjoy the local hospitality at the club after the game.
<b><i>Mon 30 July LONDON</i></b>	Today we say goodbye to Europe and head for London. Board your Eurostar train for the 3.5 hour trip to London, then transfer to our accommodation. This evening, we head to the Lee Valley Hockey Centre for the Womens Hockey World Cup playoff matches
<b><i>Tues 31 July LONDON</i></b>	With the World Cup playoff matches commencing at 6pm, you have the day to explore the English capital. Use your included Oyster Card to head into Buckingham Palace, Westminster Abbey, Trafalgar Square or any of the great sights
<b><i>Wed 1 August LONDON</i></b>	Evening quarter finals allows you the full day to explore the attractions. The London hop-on, hop-off double decker bus tours are a great way to get around all of the key sights.
<b><i>Thurs 2 August LONDON</i></b>	Another day to explore prior to the evening quarter final matches. The hop-on, hop-off bus tours are available as a 2 day pass to ensure you dont miss anything or simply use the extensive London Tube network to get around

<b><i>Fri 3 August LONDON</i></b>	With a tournament rest day today, take a trip to Stonehenge, Bath or Oxford to get out of the city. This evening, we will play our last game of the tour at a local London club.
<b><i>Sat 4 August LONDON</i></b>	Semi Final day. The World Cup is down to the last 4 teams. The action start at 2pm, and hopefully your favourite team is still in the running. Games will end around 6pm, so you can take the chance to see a West End theatre show or visit the great restaurants and bars around SOHO.
<b><i>Sun 5 August LONDON</i></b>	FINAL DAY. The Bronze medal game starts at 2pm, with the Gold Medal match from 4.30pm. At the end of the presentation, we will head out to enjoy our final night party. As Official Tour Provider for the Hockeyroos, we will look to catch up with the team, families and other supporters to finish off the tour on a high

4. All rates listed are per person
